Introduction

Romans535 Inc., a Delaware corporation and its subsidiaries and affiliates, (“Romans535”, “us”, “our”, or “we”) is committed to protecting your privacy. We created this Privacy Policy (the “Policy”) to inform you of our practices regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of your personal information when you visit our website, log into one of our platforms, attend one of our remote sessions, or otherwise use our Services (collectively the “Services”). Please read this Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we use and protect it.

Changes to this Policy.

Who Does This Privacy Policy Apply To?

This policy generally applies to all individuals from whom we collect personal information.

Information Collection

We collect several types of information about you, including:

- **Information provided by you**, such as name, address, email address, telephone number, and other personally identifying information. For example, we collect information from you when you fill out a form on our website to contact us or when you sign up for an account.
- **Information collected automatically** as you navigate through our website. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP address, internet browser, operating system, and/or session ID information.
- **Information provided by third parties** with whom you have shared your personal information.

Use of Cookies

Cookies are small pieces of information that a website sends to your computer for record-keeping purposes. This information is stored in a file on your computer. Our Services may use first-party and third-party cookies and other tracking technologies to enhance your experience when you access the Services, such as for internal analytics purposes to determine how we can improve our Services. You may choose to set your web browser to refuse cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If you choose to refuse cookies, please note that some parts of the Services may not function properly as a result.

HOW WE USE YOUR INFORMATION

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us:

- to present our Services and their contents to you and to improve our Services (we continually strive to improve our offerings based on the information and feedback we receive from you);
- to provide you with information, products, or services that you request from us;
- to fulfill our obligations to you as a customer;
- to notify you about changes to our Services or any products or services we offer or provide through them;
- to enable communications with you regarding our Services through email, text, and phone;
- to fulfill any other purpose for which you provide your information and in any other way we may describe when you provide the information; and
- for any other purpose with your consent.

DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may disclose information that we collect about you, or that you provide us directly, as described in this Policy:

- to contractors, service providers, suppliers, and other third parties we use to support our business;
- to a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by us about our website users is among the assets transferred;
- to fulfill the purpose for which you provide it, for example: to process your request for more information about our online sessions;
- for any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information;
- with your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- to comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government, regulatory, or law enforcement request;

- to enforce or apply our **Terms of Use** and other agreements, including for billing and collection purposes; and
- if we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Romans535, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

We may disclose aggregated information about our users and deidentified data or information that does not identify an individual to third parties to describe how our customers use the Services.
